ILLEGAL PARKING/ACCESS TO BEACH

Once again, illegal parking is an issue at Deanlea, and as members, it is up to ALL of us to stop this practice. The first step should be to ask the illegal "parker" to leave. Failing that:

GOLF CARTS, FOUR-WHEELERS, ETC.

Concerns have been raised about the number of golf carts and four-wheelers using the footpaths to get around Deanlea Beach. This is very dangerous and puts everyone using the footpaths at risk. Anyone with one of these vehicles is asked to use the roads and not the footpaths to get from point A to point B.

NB: Members with mobility issues and requiring one of these vehicles to reach the beach are exempted from this request.

LOUD MUSIC ON BEACH

The Beach is for everyone! Please remember to be considerate of those around you. Not everyone is into heavy metal or jazz... Please turn your music to a level so that you can hear it; and if you go into the water, please turn it off.

MEMBERSHIP FEES - REMINDER

The final push is on to get everyone to pay their \$50.00 annual fee. If you are unclear about why you should pay, here is the most important reasons: If we don't pay our taxes, insurance and other associated fees, maintain financial records, and the property in Tiny Registered Plans #793, #1481 and #M76, the Township will NOT hesitate to take over our beach.

FRIENDLY REMINDERS - DEANLEA BEACH

Deanlea Beach is a family friendly community. As property owners and members of the DBA, you are asked to share our "Friendly Reminders" with your family, friends and renters.

BEACH	- Use the buddy system and be aware of undertows and changing water levels.
	- Avoid the use of glass on the beach, whenever possible.
	- Take your garbage and cigarette butts with you when you leave the beach.
	- Do not leave beach furniture on the beach at the end of the day.
	- Fill in all sand holes. These create a serious walking hazard, especially at night!
	- Do not feed the seagulls.
	- To help with dune preservation, avoid walking on dune grasses.
DOGS	- Dogs must be leashed at ALL times – everywhere (Tiny By-law).
	- Please "scoop your dog's poop" and take it with you.
	- In July and August, Deanlea Beach is a dog-free beach between 12:00 noon and 5:00 pm.
FIRES	- Fires are allowed on <u>your</u> property with a Class A Fire Permit and a proper fire pit (Tiny Open Air Burning By-law 15-027).
44	- The By-law prohibits the burning of leaves and pine needles.
	- Fires are NOT allowed on the beach at any time.
COLO CO	- Fire bans are imposed in very dry weather. Check for fire bans and the Tiny Fire Hazard Index at

	- Permits can be obtained on-line via the Township of Tiny website, or purchased at the Township
	Municipal Office in Perkinsfield, Wyevale Jug City, or the Esso Gas Station (corner of 29 and 92).
MOTORIZED	- Please use and anchor motorized watercraft in the boating zone marked by posts and signs.
	- Motorized watercraft is not allowed in any swimming areas.
WATERCRAFT	- Motorized vessels must operate at speeds <= 10 km/h within 300 m of our shore as per
ai)	Transport Canada, Vessel Operation Restriction Regulations, Schedule 6, Item 28.
NOISE	- Please respect your neighbours and do not play loud music outdoors ((Tiny Noise By-law 11-065).
	- If you are having a party, tell your neighbour(s) beforehand.
PEN	- If noise or music is too loud, try speaking to your neighbour(s) first, before calling By-law.
